



... for sunny warmth

MATERIALS:

FUZZY WUZZY ANGORA. 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ -oz. balls Adonis Blue. (16 yrs.—9 balls) (18 yrs.—10 balls). Two No. 12 and two No. 10 Queen Bee or Aero Knitting Needles. One spare needle with points at both ends. One Medium Crochet Hook. 4 Buttons. Two Safety Pins.

MEASUREMENTS: 14 yrs. 16 yrs. 18 yrs.
Width all round at underarm 32 ins. 34 ins. 36 ins.
Length from top of shoulder 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " 19"
Length of sleeve underarm seam 5" 5" 5"

Tension: 7 sts. and 9 rows = 1 inch with No. 10 needles.

The instructions are written for size 14 yrs. Sizes 16 and 18 yrs. are written in brackets thus:—().

TO MAKE THE "TWIST": Slip next 3 sts. onto the spare needle letting this needle fall to back of work. Knit next 3 sts. Bring the 3 sts. forward and knit them.

FRONT: With No. 12 needles cast on 92 sts. (16 yrs.—98 sts.) (18 yrs.—106 sts.).

Work 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. ribbing (K1. P1). Change to No. 10 needles and proceed:

1st row: K20. (16 yrs.—K23) (18 yrs.—K27). P1. K6. P1. K4. P1. K6. P1. K12. P1. K6. P1. K4. P1. K6. P1. Knit to end of row.

2nd row: K1. P19. (16 yrs.—K1. P22) (18 yrs.—K1. P26). K1. P6. K1. P4. K1. P6. K1. P12. K1. P6. K1. P4. K1. P6. K1. Purl to last st. K1. Repeat 1st. and 2nd rows once.

5th row: K20. (16 yrs.—K23) (18 yrs.—K27). P1. Twist. P1. K4. P1. Twist. P1. K12. P1. Twist. P1. K4. P1. Twist. P1. Knit to end of row.

6th row: As 2nd row. Repeat 1st. and 2nd rows once. These 8 rows complete one pattern.

Inc. 1. st. each end of needle on next row, work 1 complete pattern.

17th row: (to move the Cable panels 1. st. towards side edges of work). Inc. 1. st. in 1st. st. K18. (16 yrs.—K21) (18 yrs.—K25). K2tog. P1. K6. P1. K4. P1. Inc. 1. st. in next st. K9. Inc. 1. st. in next st. K1. P1. K6. P1. K4. P1. K6. P1. Sl.1. K1. p.s.o. Knit to last 2 sts. Inc. 1. st. in next st. K1.


18th row: K1. P20. (16 yrs.—K1. P23) (18 yrs.—K1. P27). K1. P6. K1. P4. K1. P6. K1. P14. K1. P6. K1. P4. K1. P6. K1. Purl to last st. K1.

**Keeping Cable panels even, work remaining 6 rows of this pattern.

Inc. 1. st. each end of needle on 1st. pattern rows, work 2 more complete patterns.** 100 sts. on needle. (16 yrs.—106 sts.) (18 yrs.—114 sts.).

41st row: Inc. 1. st. in 1st. st. K20. (16 yrs.—K23) (18 yrs.—K27). K2tog. P1. K6. P1. K4. P1. Inc. 1. st. in next st. K11. Inc. 1. st. in next st. K1. P1. K6. P1. K4. P1. K6. P1. Sl.1. K1. p.s.o. Knit to last 2 sts. Inc. 1. st. in next st. K1.

42nd row: K1. P22. (16 yrs.—K1. P25) (18 yrs.—K1. P29). K1. P6. K1. P4. K1. P6. K1. P16. K1. P6. K1. P4. K1. P6. K1. Purl to last st. K1. Repeat from ** to ** once. 106 sts. on needle. (16 yrs.—112 sts.) (18 yrs.—120 sts.).



65th row: Inc. 1. st. in 1st. st. K22. (16 yrs.—K25) (18 yrs.—K29). K2tog. P1. K6. P1. K4. P1. K6. P1. Inc. 1. st. in next st. K15. Inc. 1. st. in next st. K1. P1. K6. P1. K4. P1. K6. P1. Sl.1. K1. p.s.o. Knit to last 2 sts. Inc. 1. st. in next st. K1.

66th row: K1. P24. (16 yrs.—K1. P27) (18 yrs.—K1. P31). K1. P6. K1. P4. K1. P6. K1. P18. K1. P6. K1. P4. K1. P6. K1. Purl to last st. K1. 108 sts. on needle. (16 yrs.—114 sts.) (18 yrs.—122 sts.).

Keeping Cable panels even, work remaining 6 rows of this pattern and 1 more complete pattern. Work now measures approx. 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. from beginning. (all sizes).

To shape armholes: Keeping Cable panels even, cast off 6 sts. (16 yrs.—9 sts.) (18 yrs.—11 sts.) beginning next 2 rows, then dec. 1. st. each end of needle on next and every alternate row twice ending with purl row. 90 sts. on needle. (16 yrs.—90 sts.) (18 yrs.—94 sts.).

9th row: K2tog. K12. (16 yrs.—K2tog. K12) (18 yrs.—K2tog. K14). K2tog. P1. K6. P1. K4. P1. K6. P1. Inc. 1. st. in next st. K15. Inc. 1. st. in next st. K1. P1. K6. P1. K4. P1. K6. P1. Sl.1. K1. p.s.o. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog. 88 sts. on needle. (16 yrs.—88 sts.) (18 yrs.—92 sts.).

10th row: K1. P13. (16 yrs.—K1. P13) (18 yrs.—K1. P15). K1. P6. K1. P4. K1. P6. K1. P20. K1. P6. K1. P4. K1. P6. K1. Purl to last st. K1.


Keeping Cable panels even, work remaining 6 rows of this pattern and 2 more complete patterns.

33rd row: K12. (16 yrs.—K12) (18 yrs.—K14). K2tog. P1. K6. P1. K4. P1. K6. P1. Inc. 1. st. in next st. K17. Inc. 1. st. in next st. K1. P1. K6. P1. K4. P1. K6. P1. Sl.1. K1. p.s.o. Knit to end of row.

34th row: K1. P12. (16 yrs.—K1. P12) (18 yrs.—K1. P14). K1. P6. K1. P4. K1. P6. K1. P22. K1. P6. K1. P4. K1. P6. K1. Purl to last st. K1.

Keeping Cable panels even, work remaining 6 rows of this pattern and 1 more complete pattern.

USE PATONISED WOOLS



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To shape neck: K13. (16 yrs.—K13) (18 yrs.—K15). P1. K6. P1. K4. P1. K6. P1. Turn. Leave remaining sts. on spare needle. Working on these 33 sts. (16 yrs.—33 sts.) (18 yrs.—35 sts.) and keeping continuity of pattern, dec. 1. st. at neck edge every row to 27 sts. on needle. (16 yrs.—27 sts.) (18 yrs.—29 sts.). Continue even in pattern until armhole from first shaping measures 7 ins. (16 yrs.—7 ins.) (18 yrs.—7 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins.).

To shape shoulder: Keeping continuity of pattern, at armhole edge cast off 9 sts. every alternate row 3 times. (16 yrs. as 14 yrs.). (18 yrs.—Cast off 10 sts. every alternate row twice, 9 sts. once).

Leaving next 22 sts. on safety pin, join wool at neck edge and work other side to correspond.

BACK: Work exactly as given for Front to end of 34th row above armhole shaping. 88 sts. on needle. (16 yrs.—88 sts.) (18 yrs.—92 sts.).

To make Back opening: K13. (16 yrs.—K13) (18 yrs.—K15). P1. K6. P1. K4. P1. K6. P1. K11. Turn. Leave remaining sts. on spare needle.

Working on these 44 sts. (16 yrs.—44 sts.) (18 yrs.—46 sts.) continue even in pattern until armhole from first shaping measures 7 ins. (16 yrs.—7 ins.) (18 yrs.—7 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins.).

Shape shoulder as given for Front and leave remaining 17 sts. on safety pin. (all sizes).

With right side of work facing join wool at Back opening to remaining 44 sts. (16 yrs.—44 sts.) (18 yrs.—46 sts.). and work other side to correspond. **Do not break wool.**

NECKBAND: Sew shoulder seams. Change to No. 12 needles and work in pattern across the 17 sts. at back of left side of neck. Pick up and knit 20 sts. (16 yrs.—22 sts.) (18 yrs.—24 sts.) along left side of neck. Knit across sts. from safety pin at front of neck. Pick up and knit 20 sts. (16 yrs.—22 sts.) (18 yrs.—24 sts.) along right side of neck and work in pattern across remaining 17 sts. from safety pin. Work 6 rows ribbing (K1. P1). Cast off loosely in ribbing.

SLEEVES: (Sizes 14 and 16 yrs. are written exactly the same). With No. 12 needles cast on 68 sts. (18 yrs.—76 sts.). Work 1 inch ribbing (K1. P1). Change to No. 10 needles and continue in Stocking st. inc. 1. st. each end of needle on 7th and every following 6th row to 78 sts. on needle. (18 yrs.—86 sts.). Continue even in Stocking st. until sleeve measures 5 ins. from beginning ending with purl row. (all sizes).

To shape cap: ★Cast off 2 sts. beginning next 2 rows, then 1. st. beginning following 2 rows.★ Repeat from ★ to ★ to 24 sts. on needle. (18 yrs.—26 sts.). Cast off.

TO MAKE UP: Press pieces carefully. Sew all seams. Sew in sleeves. Working 4 Ch. 3 loops for buttonholes on right side, work 1 row s.c. around Back opening. Sew buttons to correspond to buttonholes.
